



COVID 19 Risk Assessment

This risk assessment has been written in addition to activity and site specific risk assessments and should be read in conjunction with those risk assessments and the dynamic risk assessment. This risk assessment is to be used alongside our operating procedures and Domestic Safety Management (DSM) documents and while every effort should be made to follow the measures in place in this document, it is imperative that the safety of passengers and crew is paramount and any procedures outlined in the DSM relating to the safety of passengers, crew and the vessel take precedence over these measures.

Introduction

At Alert Level Zero, from August 7 2021, there are no legal limits on the number of people who can meet, including in private homes, public places or at events. In addition all businesses and premises may be open.

Although serious illness and deaths have greatly reduced as a result of the success of the vaccination programme and the rules introduced to slow the spread of coronavirus, coronavirus is still with us and still poses a significant risk to public health. We all have a responsibility to help minimise this risk to protect ourselves, our employees and customers.

STAFF MUST NOT ATTEND WORK IF THEY ARE SUFFERING FROM ANY SYMPTOMS OF COVID 19 AND MUST INFORM MANAGEMENT AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE OPPURTUNITY, OBTAIN A TEST & FOLLOW THE OFFICIAL ADVICE GIVEN.

STAFF MUST NOT ATTEND WORK IF THEY HAVE BEEN CONTACTED BY NHS CONTACT TRACING BUT MUST ISOLATE FOR THE STATED PERIOD AND FOLLOW THE ADVICE GIVEN.
